9.1 SUPERINTENDENT'S ITEMS

- A. Approved the Minutes of the Board of Education's Regular Meeting held June 9, 2011.
- B. Approved Resolution No. 38-2010/2011 declaring that Board Member Rita Jo Ramirez was absent from the June 9, 2011 regular board meeting in accordance with Education Code 35120, which allows Governing Board of Education members to be absent from board meetings and not have their monthly stipend affected.
- C. Approved Resolution No. 39-2010/2011 declaring that Board Member Dr. Joseph Rivera was absent from the June 9, 2011 regular board meeting in accordance with Education Code 35120, which allows Governing Board of Education members to be absent from board meetings and not have their monthly stipend affected.
- D. Approved agreement for services with Interquest Detection Canines of Los Angeles for contraband detection services from September 2011 through June 2012. Interquest agrees to provide 36-half day visits for the duration of the contract at \$220 per visit. Expenditures of \$7,920 are payable from General Funds.
- PULLED consultant agreement with Mr. Arnold Tovar to provide services to the El Rancho Unified School District, Division of Student Services for the period July 1, 2011 to June 30, 2012. Estimated payment of \$31,000.00 (\$650.00 per day) to be charged to Student Services.
- F. PULLED consultant agreement with Dr. Kathryn Enloe to provide services to the El Rancho Unified School District, Division of Human Resources for the period July 1, 2011 to June 30, 2012. Estimated payment of \$3,500.00 (\$350.00 per day) to be charged to Human Resources.

9.1 SUPERINTENDENT'S ITEMS

- G. Approved Resolution No. 41-2010/2011 authorizing, Dr. Myrna Rivera Coté, Superintendent, Susanna Smith, Assistant Superintendent of Education, Lydia Cano, Assistant Superintendent of Business Services, and Roberta Gonzalez, Principal of Early Learning Programs to sign required documents issued by the Los Angeles County Children and Families First-Proposition 10 Commission grant agreement transactions for the Governing Board.
- H. Approved Contract Los Angeles County Children and Families First Proposition 10 Commission (aka First 5 LA) in the amount of \$123,821.43 for the School Readiness Program. This agreement with the First 5 LA shall be in effect from July 1, 2010 to December 31, 2011.
- I. Approved establishment of Board Sub-Committee for Board Policy Revisions, and nominated Rita Jo Ramirez and Dr. Joseph Rivera to the committee.

9.2 DIVISION OF STUDENT SERVICES

- A. Approved Inter-district attendance agreements between sixteen (16) neighboring school districts. The terms of the agreements are for five (5) school years beginning July 1, 2011 and ending June 30, 2016.
- B. Approved the selection of *Alma Family Services* through the Request for Proposal process and contract agreement between El Rancho Unified School District and Alma Family Services for mental health services for the 2011-2012 school year. The contract shall not exceed \$73,000.00, which is payable from the Safe Schools/Healthy Students Grant.
- C. Approved the selection of *Penny Lane Centers* through the Request for Proposal process and contract agreement between El Rancho Unified School District and Penny Lane Centers for mental health services for the 2011-2012 school year. The total contract shall not exceed \$73,000.00. The total cost payable from budgeted Safe Schools/Healthy Students Grant.
- D. Approved Service Agreement with the *Whittier Area Cooperative Special Education Program (WACSEP)* for the 2011-2012 school year, effective August 22, 2011 through June 14, 2012. Total cost of \$113,602.92 will be payable from Special Education funds.
- E. Approved the use of the acronym CAPE, which stands for "Career and Pathway Exploration," to identify the District's Severely Handicapped Transition Program serving the 18-22 year-old student population.
- F. Approved Independent Consultant Agreement with Speech and Language Pathologist, *Lori Westcott*, for speech and language services for the 2011/2012 school year. Services are to be rendered effective August 24, 2011 through June 13, 2012, at the rate of \$400.00 per day, for 180 days. Expenditures are not to exceed \$72,000.00 payable in ten monthly payments from Special Education funds.
- G. Approved Independent Consultant Agreement with Speech and Language Pathologist, *Lori Westcott*, for speech and language services for the 2011 Summer Session. Services are to be rendered effective June 25, 2011 through July 22, 2011, at the rate of \$35.00 per hour, for 6 hour per day. Expenditures are not to exceed \$3,990.00 payable from Special Education funds.

9.2 DIVISION OF STUDENT SERVICES

- H. Approved contract with *Rodric Rhodes, Ph.D., LCSW*, to provide executive functioning skills to student. The district's payment responsibility per session is the parent's deductible, which is 30% of total cost, totaling an amount of \$150.00 per session. Services are to be rendered from July 1, 2011 to June 30, 2012. Expenditures are not to exceed \$900.00, which is to be paid from Special Education account.
- I. Approved Consultant Agreement with *Peggy Bailey Lett, M.A. & Associates*. The Consultant will provide an IEP mandated reading program for two (2) hours per week. Services will be provided from July 1, 2011 to June 30, 2012. Estimated expenditure of \$6,000.00 to be payable from Special Education account.
- J. Approved agreement with parents to transport student to and from non-public School. Reimbursement is at the federal rate, five (5) days a week from July 1, 2011 to June 30, 2012. Expenditures are not to exceed \$8,000.00, which is to be paid from the Special Education Account.
- K. Approved consultant agreement with *Autism Spectrum Therapies* to provide Positive Behavior Support Services with 702 hours of Direct Intervention at the rate of \$75.00 per hour, and Supervision Services for 94 hours at the rate of \$125.00 per hour. Services are to be rendered from July 1, 2011 to June 30, 2012. Expenditures are not to exceed \$64,400.00, which is to be paid from the Special Education Account.
- L. Approved consultant agreement with *Autism Spectrum Therapies* to provide Positive Behavioral Support Services with 84 hours of Supervision Services at the rate of \$125.00 per hour. Services are to be rendered from July 1, 2011 to June 30, 2012. Expenditures not to exceed \$10,500.00 are to be paid from the Special Education Account.
- M. Approved agreement with *Autism Spectrum Therapies* to provide Behavioral Supervision services to student from July 1, 2011 to June 30, 2012. Expenditures not to exceed \$10,000.00 are to be paid from the Special Education Account.
- N. Approved agreement with *Autism Spectrum Therapies* to provide IEP mandated Behavioral Supervision services to student from July 1, 2011 to June 30, 2012. Expenditures not to exceed \$15,000.00 are to be paid from the Special Education Account.
- O. Approved Consultant Agreement with *Villa Esperanza Services School* for an IEP mandated Occupational Therapy evaluation for a Special Education student. Services to be provided from July 1, 2011 to June 30, 2012, expenditures are not to exceed \$540.00, which is to be paid from the Special Education Account.
- P. Approved Consultant Agreement with *Villa Esperanza Services School* for an IEP mandated Speech & Language Assessment for a Special Education student. Services are to be provided from July 1, 2011 to June 30, 2012. Expenditures are not to exceed \$540.00, which is to be paid from the Special Education Account.
- Q. Approved agreement with parents to be reimbursed for IEP mandated transportation services in the amount of ten dollars (\$10.00) per day of Student's actual days of attendance at school from July 1, 2011 to June 30, 2012. Expenditure is not to exceed \$2,420.00 which is payable from the Special Education account.

9.2 DIVISION OF STUDENT SERVICES

- R. Approved agreement with consultant, *Augmentative Communication Therapies*, to provide IEP mandated augmentative communication consultation services for student at \$135.00 per hour, 18 times per year. Expenditures are not to exceed \$2,430.00, which is to be paid from the Special Education Account.
- S. Approved contract with *SEEK Education, Inc.* to provide IEP mandated behavior consultation services for student. Services are to be rendered from July 1, 2011 to June 30, 2012. Expenditures are not to exceed \$2,514.00, which is to be paid from the Special Education Account.
- T. Approved contract with *Whittier Area Parents' Association for the Developmentally Handicapped (WAPADH)* for augmentative communication services for student. Services to be rendered from July 1, 2011 to June 30, 2012 are payable at the rate of \$125.00 per hour, for a total expenditure not to exceed \$2,500.00 payable from the Special Education Account.
- U. Approved contract with *Whittier Area Parents' Association for the Developmentally Handicapped (WAPADH)* for augmentative communication services for student. Services to be rendered from July 1, 2011 to June 30, 2012 are payable at the rate of \$125.00 per hour, for a total expenditure not to exceed \$2,500.00 payable from the Special Education Account.

9.3 DIVISION OF EDUCATIONAL SERVICES

- A. Approved attendance for two (2) certificated staff members from El Rancho High School to the Summer 2011 K-12 Education Workshop – Stanford Design School in Stanford, California, July 13 through July 15, 2011. Total expenditure of \$1,292.66 for travel, lodging, and meals (registration is free) payable from El Rancho High School 2011-2012 EIA/SCE Funds.
- B. Approved participation for five (5) Migrant Education students in a five-day Outdoor Education Program at Camp Morning Star in the San Bernardino Mountains June 20 through June 24, 2011, under the direction of the Los Angeles County Office of Education Migrant Education Program/Consortium X and the supervision of the Mini-Corps Program. There is no cost to the district.
- C. Approved consultant agreement with CF Educational Resources to provide mandated services to El Rancho Unified School District in response to the district's identification as a District Assistance Intervention Team (DAIT) district. Agreement is for two years, effective July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2013. Consultant will be paid \$105,340.00 for year one (monthly payments of \$8778.33); \$52,670.00 for year two (monthly payments of \$4,389.17). Total expenditure of \$158,010.00, for two years, payable from Program Improvement Local Educational Agencies Corrective Action Resources Funds.
- D. Approved consultant agreement with Eduneering, Inc. to provide mandated services to El Rancho Unified School District in response to the district's identification as a District Assistance Intervention Team (DAIT) district. Agreement is for two years, effective July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2013. Consultant will be paid \$105,340.00 for year one (monthly payments of \$8778.33); \$52,670.00 for year two (monthly payments of \$4,389.17). Total expenditure of \$158,010.00, for two years, payable from Program Improvement Local Educational Agencies Corrective Action Resources Funds.

- E. Approved as amended consultant agreement with CF Educational Resources to support the integration of the mandated District Assistance Intervention Team (DAIT) requirements into the Educational Services Strategic Plan. The consultant will also complete a comprehensive review of all Board policies related to curriculum and instruction as required to implement the policy decisions of the Board of Education in the area of improving student achievement, effective June 24, 2011 (for a total of 14 off-site work days). Total expenditure of \$24,000.00 \$17,500.00 payable from Centralized Title I Program Improvement Year 3 Funds.
- F. Approved **as amended** submission of the District's 2011-2016 2010-2014 Local Educational Agency (LEA) Plan to the California Department of Education. (Upon request, the LEA Plan is available for review in the Educational Services Office.)
- G. Approved contract between El Rancho Unified School District and Adrylan Communications, Inc., for access to the Educator's Assessment Data Management System (EADMS) for the 2011-2012 school year, effective July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012. Total expenditure of \$116,398.00 will be paid at the beginning of the contract period, as stipulated in the contract, and is payable from Title I (50%), EIA/SCE (45%), and Title III (5%) Funds.
