Payment of \$5,087.08 to be made by the district as specified in the Individual Service Agreement, in accordance with Education Code Sections 56157 and 56365-56366.7, payable through Special Education funds.
- L. Approve/Ratify Addendum to the Individual Service Agreement previously approved on September 9, 2009, item 37.2 through the Whittier Area Cooperative Special Education Program between El Rancho Unified School District and *Pyramid Autism Center, Inc.* The purpose of this addendum is to delete 200 days of service for Student who transferred to another non-public school. Services are to be rendered from July 6, 2009 through June 11, 2010 for a new total rate of \$15,059.25.
