139 Discuss and approve a District wide campaign to stop the financial loss of revenue as it pertains to student attendance throughout the District. The District will do this by informing all District personnel of the campaign and responsibilities to move the attitude or culture of the students and their families about student attendance. The campaign will include members of the community, law enforcement and Pico Rivera city employees' assistance in this campaign. A zero tolerance towards absences will be implemented and a task force involving stake holders to meet to discuss the implementation of this campaign immediately.

Approved a district-wide campaign to remediate the financial loss of revenue as it pertains to student attendance throughout the district. Presently, the district maintains a 97% positive attendance rate. However, it appears that the outstanding 3% of students not attending class impedes the districts ability to maximize ADA revenue.

As such, the district will promote such campaign by effectively organizing all resources, under the Division of Student Services, including, but not limited to, SARB hearings, truancy sweeps, tardy citations, home visits, district and city efforts, etc. into one effective entity to maintain and increase the 97% ADA rate. More importantly, the district will conduct a more intensive campaign utilizing the aforementioned resources to effectively target the 3% absenteeism rate and work towards a goal to decrease such rate by 1% or greater.

Finally, the district will conduct a Student Attendance campaign indicating a "zero tolerance" towards unexcused absences. A "public awareness" campaign promoting that "Every School Day Counts" is to be communicated to all students, parents, teachers, school support staff, law enforcement, community stakeholders, city employees and city officials.
