## RIGHTS, RESPONSIBILITIES AND DUTIES

Teachers must consider teaching school their primary job to which their allegiance and energy are due. Regardless of social or business commitments, teaching should come first. The continued success and progress of the education program depends largely on the wholehearted zeal of the staff, both teaching and non-teaching members, in working together.

The duties and functions of a classroom teacher are those of normal teaching situations and are determined to a great extent by Governing Board policy, administrative regulations, the principal and the educational philosophy of the school system.
