  - Staff Development
  - Homeless students
- Federal Funding For Schools
  - Title 1 Helping students reach grade level standards in ELA and Math
    \$2,116,475.00
  - Title 2 Staff Development for teachers and Administration
    - \$306,385.00
  - o Title 3 \_ Helping EL's attain English Proficiency and reach grade level standards
    - LEP \$170,587.00
    - Immigrants \$8,841.00

- Categorical Programs must supplement NOT supplant the regular educational program
- Categorical funds cannot be used for the core program.
