V. CAASPP Data Trends:

- ERUSD CAASPP Scores showed positive two-year growth in grades 3-5 for ELA and Math (percent proficient growth ranging from 1% to 10% in the various grade levels in ELA and Math).
- ERUSD had double digit two-year growth in 4th grade ELA and Math
 - percent proficient grew by 10% in both ELA and Math
- El Rancho High School continues to exceed the county and state averages in ELA
 - 2018 - ERHS 60% proficient, state 56% proficient, county 56% proficient
- Ultimate Goal is Student Learning and Mastery of Standards, as well as articulating learning and showing it.

VI. Positive Behavior Intervention Supports (PBIS):

- Nine schools received recognition for their work with Positive Behavior Intervention and Supports for the year 2017-2018 school year. All schools in ERUSD that participated in PBIS were recognized.

VII. LCFF/LCAP Update:

- The LCAP needs to be revised every year to ensure the district is following the LCAP.
- The LCAP is a critical part of the new Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF).
- The LCAP is a tool for local educational agencies to set goals, plan actions, and leverage resources to meet those goals to improve student outcomes.
- Discussed all the LCAP goals.

VIII. Other Business, as needed:

- Summer school was difficult for Birney Tech to commute to Rivera ES.
- Sports 4 Learning was offered in summer school.
- Camp Innovation - integrated all the core subjects during the summer school.
