## LCAP Community Survey

#### **English**

- ♦ 487 surveys collected
- ▶ Parents = 70%
- ♦ Community Members = 30%

#### **Spanish**

- 47 surveys collected
- $\bullet$  Parents = 91%
- ♦ Community = 9%

Total Surveys = 534
