- Monica Sorenson emphasized the importance of giving feedback to staff on the status of the budget and the superintendent search.

- Alfred Renteria wished everyone a happy Valentine's Day. He announced that he attended the recent swearing-in ceremony for Assemblywoman Cristina Garcia.
- Rita Jo Ramirez thanked the audience for coming to the meeting. She commented about teachers being laid off and losing their homes.
- Rachel Canchola expressed the need to schedule the second half of the Board Governance Workshop. She offered her congratulations to the newly selected Montebello Unified Co-Superintendent, Susanna Contreras Smith. She requested to schedule a special meeting to discuss our English Language Learner students.
- Dr. Joseph Rivera wished everyone a happy Valentine's Day. He recently had the opportunity to conduct a presentation for LACOE Special Education Homeless Project. He offered congratulations to the District for being awarded a \$12,000.00 grant, with the assistance of California Consulting, to enhance soccer fields. We are also pursuing an additional grant opportunity for STEM at the K-8 level. Dr. Rivera attended the swearing-in ceremony for Assemblywoman Cristina Garcia. He shared a concern about ACLU threatening a potential lawsuit against the State Department of Education regarding long term English Language Learners. He feels ERUSD needs to start looking at our ELL students that are not transitioning out. He stressed the need to follow up on the CSBA Governance training and the possibility of establishing a vision on where we are going as a District.

• Norbert Genis spoke of declining enrollment and how it plays a heavy roll in school funding; ERUSD enrollment is dropping quickly. We are establishing a task force/committee to look at declining enrollment and what we can do to maintain and attract more students.
