- Jose Lara commented on the effects of the passage of Proposition 30 and putting the monies into restoring a full school year.

Ms. Canchola also attended the CSBA Conference. She commented about the District's 3% budget reserve; reaching that percentage was not an easy task. She asked that everyone support the employees that have had recent tragedies occur in their lives.
- Dr. Joseph Rivera welcomed Maribel Medina, new District legal counsel. He asked for the El Rancho family to assist Salazar High teacher, Erin Lopez who recently lost her home and possessions to a fire. He recently attended an Economic Development meeting. Dr. Rivera spoke of accountability guidelines on Proposition 30 that outline specifically what school districts can spend the funds on.
