106 Adopted the minutes of the Board of Education's regular meeting held February 12, 2009.

CONSENT AGENDA:

107 DIVISION OF STUDENT SERVICES – Arnold Tovar (562) 801-4810

- .1 Authorized the administration to submit for approval to the California Department of Education a waiver of Education Code Section 48661, allowing both the Community Day School program and Salazar Continuation High School to be housed on the same site.
- .2 Approved/Ratified Addendum to Individual Service Agreement through the Whittier Area Cooperative Special Education Program between El Rancho Unified School District and Gallagher Pediatric Therapy. Both parties agree that all conditions contained in the ISA for student shall remain the same with the following changes: Add a total of 3 sessions of occupational therapy services for additional evaluations effective January 21, 2008 through June 30, 2009 at \$87.00 per session for a total of \$261.00. The current contract amount is \$87.00; the new Individual Service Agreement amount will be \$348.00.
- . 3 Approved contract with DG Therapy Group, Inc., for Occupational Therapy services one (1) time per week for student from March 12, 2009 to June 30, 2009. Expenditures are not to exceed \$1,920.00, which is to be paid from the Special Education Account.
- .4 Approved/Ratified contract with Dr. Michael Salce, Educational Psychologist for a complete Psycho-Education Assessment of student and attendance at an IEP. Services provided are from February 6, 2009 to February 12, 2009. Expenditure not to exceed \$2,500.00 is payable from the Special Education Account.

- . 6 Approved contract with parents to transport student to Adaptive Physical Education services at Big Fun Therapy Services. Services are to be provided from March 12, 2009 to June 30, 2009. Mileage reimbursement is to be calculated at \$100.00 per day, not to exceed \$3,000.00, to be paid from the Special Education Account.
- .7 Approved/Ratified Master Contract and Individual Service Tuition Agreement between El Rancho Unified School District and <u>Rossier Park Jr./Sr. High School.</u> El Rancho Unified School District students will attend this school as defined in Item 18 under General Provisions with payment of \$15,215.35 to be made by the district as specified in the Individual Service Agreement in accordance with Education Code Sections 56157 and 56365-56366.7 payable through Special Education funds.

- .1 Approved/Ratified attendance for two (2) certificated staff members from Durfee Elementary School to the 2009 California Kindergarten Conference on February 27-28, 2009 in Pasadena, California. Total expenditures of \$408, for conference registration and parking fees, payable from Durfee Elementary School Title 1 funds.
- .2 Approved attendance for one (1) classified staff member from South Ranchito Elementary School to the "Administrative Assistants Conference," sponsored by Skill Path Seminars, on April 2, 2009 in Anaheim. Total expenditure of \$199 is payable from South Ranchito Elementary School Title I/Professional Development funds.
- .3 Approved trip to Sacramento by El Rancho High School's Academic Decathlon Team to participate in state competition. The team received a wild card due to a high overall score to compete at State level. The objective of this competition is to qualify to compete at National level. Total expenditure of \$6,634.00, for lodging, meals, and airfare will be paid from general funds.
- .4 Approved athletic field trip for 65 students and two (2) certificated staff members from North Park Middle School to the Amateur Athletic Foundation of Los Angeles (AAF) and Mt. SAC Relays 2009 Youth Days at Mt. San Antonio College in Walnut, California on April 3, 2009. Total expenditure of \$450.00, for transportation, is payable from North Park Middle School ASB funds, at no cost to the District.
- .5 Approved extended educational field trip for forty (40) El Rancho High School AP Club students and two (2) certificated staff members to UC San Diego, in San Diego, CA, Thursday, April 16, 2009 from 7:00 a.m. 3:30 p.m.; and authorize transportation agreement with King Limousine Bus Services. There is no cost for admission. Total estimated cost of \$850.00 for transportation payable from El Rancho High School AP Club funds, at no cost to the District.
- . 6 Approved educational field trip for 26 students, one (1) certificated staff member, and (2) adult chaperones from El Rancho High School to the Fullerton Jazz Festival, in Fullerton, California on Friday, April 3, 2009. Transportation will be provided El Rancho Vans. Expenditures of \$232.00 are payable through the Choral Account/El Rancho High School ASB fund (includes student fundraisers), at cost to the District.

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- .7 Approved extended educational field trip for thirty-seven (37) El Rancho High School students and five (5) certificated staff members to Paris, Florence, and Venice April 1-10, 2010. Transportation will be provided by United Airlines and Education First Coach Bus Lines. Total expenditures of \$107,497.00 payable from El Rancho High School Gadabouts Club funds and individual participants, at no cost to the District.
- .8 Approved consultant agreements with Shirley Coddington, Christina Jerome, Andrew Medina, Curtis Valdepena and Nichole Smith to accompany students in the El Rancho High School Chorale Department during competitions for 2008-09 school year. The accompanists will be paid per competition worked and will be paid at the end of April and on June 15, 2009. Total expense of \$3,275.00 will be paid from El Rancho High School Art and Music Grant funds.
- .9 Approved consultant assignment with Parent Institute for Quality Education (PIQE) to provide a parent educational program, effective April 22nd through June 17, 2009. Total expenditure of \$2,400 payable from South Ranchito Elementary School Title I funds.
