ADOPTION OF MINUTES:

Adopted the minutes of the Board of Education's regular meeting held October 11, 2007 and special meeting held October 25, 2007.

O57 SUPERINTENDENT – Norbert Genis (562) 801-5199

- .1 Approved reclassification of Board agenda/backup hardcopies to Class III Disposable for school years 1998/1999 and 1999/2000, so they may be destroyed. These records have been scanned to Laser Fiche for permanent retention.
- .2 Approved attendance for the School Readiness Supervisor, to attend Dr. Jean's "Razzle Dazzle" Centers & Activities for Reading, Writing & Math Conference in Ontario, California, December 4, 2007. The conference is sponsored by the California Elementary Education Association. Registration of \$189.00 is payable from School Readiness funds.
- Approved attendance for (2) Certificated staff members from the Early Learning Program to attend "Understanding Behavior from the Outside In" conference in Pomona, California, January 25, 2008. The conference is sponsored by The Infant Development Association of California. Registration of \$160 per person is payable from School Readiness funds and Early Learning Programs.
