- .1 Approved attendance for Franklin Covey workshop for Director, Program Specialist, Administrative Secretary I, and Department Secretary. Productivity and Leadership Workshop will be held on May 8, 2007 in Long Beach, California in the estimated amount of \$1,208.00 payable from Special Education account.
