## **211 SUPERINTENDENT** – Norbert Genis (562) 801-5199

- .1 Approved Resolution No. 35-2006/2007 declaring that Board Member Lupe Salas was absent from the May 10, 2007 regular board meeting due to illness. Education Code 35120 allows Governing Board of Education members to be absent from board meetings and not have their monthly stipend affected.
- .2 Approved attendance of Director and Supervisor of Early Learning Programs to the Professional Association for Childhood Education (PACE) Formula for Improved Staff Retention and Legislative Directions in 2007 workshop in Pasadena on June 26, 2007. Expenditures of \$80.00 payable from State Preschool Funds.

### 212 SPECIAL & ALTERNATIVE EDUCATION – Arnold Tovar (562) 801-4810

- .1 Approved 120 (one hundred twenty hours) of summer employment at El Rancho High School and the Career Connection Center Job Club. Vocational Coordinator at the El Rancho High School will work with the El Rancho students. Whittier Union High School District will be billed by El Rancho Unified School District. Payment will be made from Whittier Union High School District Work Ability Account for 120 (one hundred twenty) hours.
- .2 Approved agreement for Vision Screening with Dr. Wayne W. Hoeft, O.D. for the 2007/2008 school year. Cost of services \$3.25 per student payable from the Health Services/General fund budget account not to exceed \$15,000.00.

- .1 Approved attendance for five (5) parents from Birney Elementary School to the California Science Center Toys that Teach conference on June 30, 2007 in Santa Ana, California. Expenditure of \$100.00 for registration is payable from Birney Elementary School Title I funds.
- .2 Approved attendance for five (5) El Rancho High School teachers to the LANGUAGE! Third Edition Training conference on August 20-24, 2007 in Pasadena, California. The teachers will be compensated at the District's hourly rate of \$33.32 x 40 hours for attending the training. Expenditure of approximately \$3,750.00, for registration, payable from El Rancho High School Title I Funds.
- .3 Approved participation of ten (10) El Rancho High School Girls' Volleyball Team members and one (1) certificated staff member in the Cerritos College Volleyball Summer League Camp July 9 25, 2007. Transportation will be provided by El Rancho Vans. Total expenditure of \$200.00 for team participation is payable from El Rancho High School ASB Volleyball funds.
- .4 Approved educational field trip for twelve (12) eight grade students and two (2) certificated staff members from North Park Middle School to Washington, DC and Gettysburg, Pennsylvania May 28 June 1, 2007. Total expenditure of approximately \$14,924.00 is payable from North Park Middle School ASB funds (bus transportation: \$500.00), SLIBG funds (substitute teachers: \$600.00), and fundraisers and individual participants (student costs: \$13,824.00). There is no cost to the chaperoning teachers or to the District.

- Approved educational field trip for forty-eight (48) third, fourth, and fifth grade GATE students, twelve (12) parent volunteers, and two (2) certificated teachers from Durfee and Obregon Elementary Schools to see the performance of "Wicked" at the Pantages Theater, Hollywood, California on Sunday, June 17, 2007. Transportation will be provided by PTC. Admission deposit of \$2,230 will be paid by, and reimbursed to Durfee PTO. Transportation fees of \$350 payable from Obregon GATE funds. Total expenditure will be \$2580.00, for entry fees and transportation, payable from Durfee GATE (\$1398.00), Obregon GATE (\$798), and Durfee Elementary School Discretionary Block Grant funds (\$384).
- Approved end of year, promotional field trip for 100 fifth graders, three (3) certificated staff members and one (1) staff member from Meller Elementary School to Knott's Berry Farm on Friday, June 8, 2007, from 9:00 a.m. to approximately 6:00 p.m. Total expenditure of \$2195.00, for admission and transportation, is payable from Meller Elementary School PTO funds.
- .7 Approved consultant agreement with Camfel Productions for three "Be the Change" bullying and personal responsibility assemblies for 6th, 7th, and 8th grade North Park Middle School students on May 25, 2007. Total expenditure of \$795.00 consultant fee is payable from North Park Middle School ASB funds.
- .8 Approved agreement with Viatron Systems Inc. to convert El Rancho Adult School pupil records into digital format. Viatron Systems Inc. will scan and convert approximately 127,400 pages of pupil records into digital format. Agreement will be from May 25, 2007 to approximate completion date of August 20, 2007. Total expenditure of \$8,919.00 will be paid from the Adult School funds.
- .9 Approved the participation of the El Rancho Unified School District in the Community Based English Tutoring Program (CBET) for the 2007-2008 school year. This program will allow the District to provide free English language acquisition instruction (ESL) to adults who pledge to tutor the limited English proficiency students of Pico Rivera.
