- .2 Approved Resolution No. 1-2007/2008 declaring that Board Member Delia Alvidrez was absent from the June 28, 2007 regular board meeting due to illness. Education Code 35120 allows Governing Board of Education members to be absent from board meetings and not have their monthly stipend affected.
- .3 Approved Resolution No. 2-2007/2008 declaring that Board Member Rita Jo Ramirez was absent from the June 28, 2007 regular board meeting due to a hardship deemed acceptable by the Board. Education Code 35120 allows Governing Board of Education members to be absent from board meetings and not have their monthly stipend affected.
- . 4 Approved Resolution No. 3-2007/2008 in Support of HR 82, the Social Security Fairness Act of 2007.
- .5 Approved Resolution No. 4-2007/2008 Requesting the Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles, California, to Sell Bonds of Said District in an Aggregate Principal Amount not to exceed \$6,200,000, Prescribing the Use of Bond Proceeds, Approving an Official Statement and Certain Other Matters Relating Thereto.

SPECIAL & ALTERNATIVE EDUCATION – Arnold Tovar (562) 801-4810

.1 Approved a maximum of ten IEP mandated bus training trips each for Burke, Rivera and North Park Middle Schools, and a maximum of twenty IEP mandated bus training trips for El Rancho High School for school year 2007/2008. Bus tokens provided by the Career Connection program at no cost to the district.

SPECIAL & ALTERNATIVE EDUCATION – Arnold Tovar (562) 801-4810

- .2 Approved amended contract with Leader Services dated April 12, 2007 (Item 172.2) to provide Medi-Cal Local Education Agencies (LEA) Billing Option Claiming Services for contract period July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008. The El Rancho Unified School District shall pay Leader Services a per unit fee for claims processed, not to exceed 10% of Medi-Cal claims processed.
- .3 Approved attendance for three (3) Special Education Teachers and two (2) Speech and Language Pathologists to Lindamood-Bell Learning Processes in Riverside, California. The workshops will be held July 16 26, 2007, to include registration and mileage. Expenditures of approximately \$3,194.00 payable from the Special Education account.
- . 4 Approved consultant agreement with Teresa Dean Nichols, Deaf Consultant to provide Sign Language services to student from July 1, 2007 to October 31, 2007. Expenditure of \$935.00 is payable from the Special Education Account.
- Ratified contract for services rendered by parents for transportation services beginning July 1, 2007 to June 30, 2008. Reimbursement estimated mileage to be calculated at the federal rate, not to exceed \$4,000.00, to be paid from the Special Education Account.
- .6 Ratified consultant agreement with *Autism Spectrum Therapies* to provide Direct Interventions for 200 hours at the rate of \$75.00 per hour, and Supervision Services for 40 hours at the rate of \$125.00 per hour. Services are from June 30, 2007 to August 31, 2007. Expenditures to be paid from Special Education Account, total not to exceed \$20,000.00.
- .7 Ratified contract with consultant *Augmentative Communication Therapies* for an estimated expenditure of \$125.00 per hour, twice per week of speech and language services for an estimated total of \$13,000.00 to be paid through Special Education Account.
- .8 Ratified Consultant Agreement with *Big Fun Gym* for services for strength, endurance and social skills in lieu of Adaptive Physical Education for a Special education student. Total estimated amount of \$28,600.00 of expenditure is to be paid through Special Education account.

- .1 Approved participation of thirty (30) Cross Country Team students/athletes and three (3) certificated staff members from El Rancho High School in Big Bear Camp August 5 13, 2007, in Big Bear, CA. Total expenditure of \$7,500.00, which includes PTC charter transportation, meals, and accommodations at the Black Forest Lodge, is payable from El Rancho High School ASB Cross County funds, student fundraisers and parents, at no cost to the District.
