- . 1 Adopted Resolution No. 26-2001/2002, Classified School Employee Week, May 19-25, 2002.
- . 2 Approved attendance of Board Members and central office administrators to the NALEO 19th Annual Conference in Albuquerque, New Mexico, June 26-29, 2002. Expenses will be payable from the Board or central office conference accounts, as appropriate.

- .1 Approved/ratified educational field trips for 119 4th grade students, 4 teachers, and parent volunteers from South Ranchito Elementary School to the Natural History Museum --two classes on May 1, 2002 and two classes on May 2, 2002, and transportation by Laidlaw Transit. Transportation costs paid by the Natural History Museum.
- . 2 Approved educational field trips for 40 5th grade students, 2 teachers, 2 instructional aides, and adult volunteers on May 17, 2002 and 60 5th grade students, 2 teachers, 2 instructional aides, and adult volunteers on May 24, 2002 from Birney Elementary School, and Transportation Agreement with Richmond Bus Company. Total transportation costs of \$660 payable from SIP funds.

The bike ride from El Rancho High School to the Santa Fe Dam Recreation Area will be on the San Gabriel Riverbed bike trail. Students will be required to submit parent permission slips indicating that private transportation will be provided. No cost to the District will be incurred.
- .4 Approved attendance of the El Rancho High School Pepsters and Drill Team (48 members) and 4 parent volunteers to USA Spirit Camp at Cal Lutheran in Thousand Oaks on July 19-22, 2002. Total expenditure of \$13,200 (registration fee of \$275 per participant) is payable by individual student fundraisers. Transportation provided by participants at no cost to the District.
- .5 Approved consultant agreement with Storytellers and Troubadours, consultants, to provide four assemblies in the area of language development for students at South Ranchito Elementary School. - .5 Approved the Family Healthfest Day to provide parent education to parents of the Child Development Programs. Prevention techniques and awareness of healthy habits will be stressed to participants. All costs will be funded by the WIC (Women, Infants, Children) Task Force.
- Approved educational field trip to "The Lion King" performance at the Pantages Theater in Hollywood on Sunday, June 9, 2002 for (32) GATE students, two identified high achieving students (GATE program participants) one GATE coordinator and three classroom teachers (total 38 participants) from North Ranchito Elementary School. Estimated total expenditures of \$1,558.00/admission and \$300.00/PTC transportation (total \$1,858.00) payable from GATE funds.
- .7 Approved amendment to Board Item 164.8, approved March 12, 2002, for consultant agreement with Rod Paterson, to provide one individual special education assessment for an El Rancho Unified School District student, to increase the rate to \$800.00, payable from Special & Alternative Education/Psychological Services funds.
